The Tri-County Council for Southern Maryland (TCCSMD) is applying for State financial assistance under the State Coordination and Technical Assistance (SCATA) funds, formerly Rural and Community Based Services (RCB) program, which provides funds for public transit services, to support the continuation of the Regional Transportation Coordination Program for Calvert, Charles, and St. Mary's Counties. The program is a regional coordination effort between the three Southern Maryland counties of Calvert, Charles, and St. Mary's, and is guided by a regional committee that includes transportation providers, human service agencies, and workforce development organizations. The program includes on-going review and assessment of current transportation services in the region; establishment of coordination activities in order to provide more efficient human service and public transportation, especially to the elderly and disabled; marketing of regional transportation services; and a detailed action plan to meet the goals of establishing reduced costs associated with training, insurance costs and maintenance.

Comments will be received up to February 16th, 2024. Written comments must indicate the name, address, and telephone number (home and work) of the person making the comment and the name of any other party whom the person making the comment may represent. Written comments will be considered in the preparation of the final Plan revision.

If significant community input is received, a formal public hearing on this proposal may be scheduled at a later date.

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
