

In the spirit of "many hands make light work," I thought about something I could contribute to the newsletter and that I already want and/or like to do.

- · I like to hike.
- · I like to try new restaurants.
- · I like art.
- · I like to visit new places.
- · I like to share information.
- · I set myself a goal to take at least one hike a month this year.
- · For years, I've been thinking about starting a blog but wasn't sure what I'd write about.

So here's what I figured out: I'm going somewhere in Charles County – a trail, a restaurant, a museum, a park, etc. – and then I'll tell you what I thought. I'm also going to post it in our Citizens Academy Facebook group so we can chat about it afterwards. I'll even take suggestions of places you've visited or places you haven't but would like to hear about. And then I'm taking these bits and I'll turn them into blog posts when I figure out my blog's name.

The first place I'll tell you about is Smallwood State Park. I've hiked there many times – the pandemic gave me that time – and it's different every season. In the spring you'll see the daffodils that escaped from the garden of Smallwood's Retreat. Summer is great for boating – there's a kayak launch near the boat launches. Fall is perfect for hiking and pawpaws. Winter weather is dicey but it's good brisk hiking weather, you can visit the Mattawoman Creek Art Center's winter shows and sales, there's a colonial Christmas event, AND you can join a group for the First Day Hike on January 1.

Advice you can easily disregard:

- 1) If you take General's Walk Trail clockwise, you'll go down the steepest part of the trail. Go counterclockwise for a little more challenge.
- 2) I usually park at the bottom of the trail by the boat launches because I love crossing the bridge, but you can just as easily park at the top of the trail by Smallwood's Retreat. There are playgrounds at both ends.


